


Psalm 21

*Domine, in virtute tua*

tone VI

THE King shall rejoice in thy strength, O Lord: exceeding glad shall he be of  
 thy sal - vation. 2. Thou hast given him his heart's desire: and hast not de-  
 nied him the request of his lips. 3. For thou shalt prevent him with the bless-  
 ings of goodness: and shalt set a crown of pure gold up - on his head.  
 4. He ask-ed life of thee, and thou gavest him a long life: even for ever and  
 ever. 5. His honour is great in thy salvation: glory and great worship shalt  
 thou lay up - on him. 6. For thou shalt give him ever-lasting feli-city:  
 and make him glad with the joy of thy countenance. 7. And why? because the  
 King putteth his trust in the Lord: and in the mercy of the most Highest  
 he shall not mis-carry. 8. All thine enemies shall feel thine hand: thy right  
 hand shall find out them that hate thee. 9. Thou shalt make them like a fiery  
 oven in time of thy wrath: the Lord shall destroy them in his displeasure,  
 and the fire shall con - sume them. 10. Their fruit shalt thou root out of



the earth: and their seed from among the children of men. 11. For they intend mischief against thee: and imagin-ed such a device as they are not a-ble to perform.<sup>12</sup> Therefore shalt thou put them to flight: and the strings of thy bow shalt thou make ready against the face of them. 13. Be thou exalted, Lord, in thine own strength: so we will sing, and praise thy power. Glo-ry be to the Father, and to the Son: and to the Holy Ghost; As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be: world without end. Amen
