



Psalm 38

*Domine, ne in furore*






my kinsmen stood afar off. 12. They al-

even as a man that heareth not: and in whose mouth are no reproofs.




15. For in thee, O Lord, have I put my trust: thou shalt answer for me, O Lord

o-ver me: for when my foot slipped, they rejoiced greatly against me. 17. And




I, truly, am set in the plague: and my heaviness is ever in my sight.
