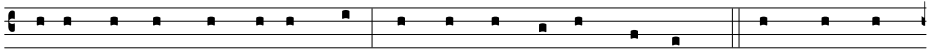


Psalm 48

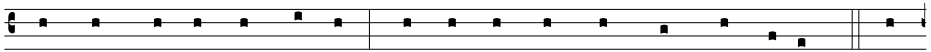
Magnus Dominus

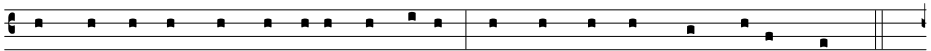
GREAT is the Lord, and highly to be praised: in the cit-y of our God, even
 upon his ho-ly hill. 2. The hill of Sion is a fair place, and the joy of the
 whole earth: upon the north- side li-eth the city of the great King; God is well
 known in her palaces as a sure refuge. 3. For lo, the kings of the earth: are
 gathered, and gone by to-gether. 4. They marvell-ed to see such things: they
 were aston-ished, and suddenly cast down. 5. Fear came there upon them, and
 sorrow: as up-on a woman in her travail. 6. Thou shalt break the ships
 of the sea: through the east- wind. 7. Like as we have heard, so have we seen
 in the city of the Lord of hosts, in the cit-y of our God: God upholdeth the
 same for ev-er. 8. We wait for thy loving- kindness, O God: in the midst of
 thy temple. 9. O God, according to thy Name, so is thy praise unto the world's
 end: thy right hand is full of righteousness. 10. Let the mount Si-on rejoice,
 and the daughters of Judah be glad: because of thy judgements. 11. Walk about



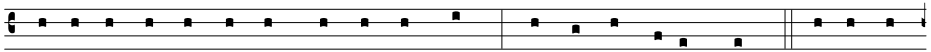
Sion, and go round about her: and tell the towers thereof. 12. Mark well her



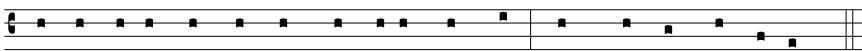
bulwarks, set up her houses: that ye may tell them that come after. 13. For
