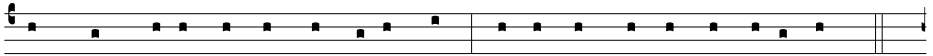

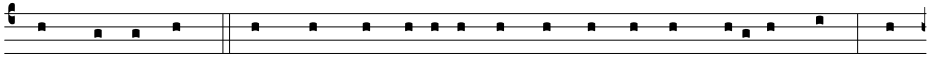

MY SOUL truly waiteth still upon God: for of him cometh my salvation.



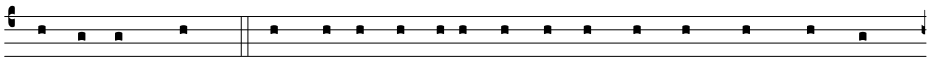
2. He ver-ily is my strength and my salvation: he is my defence, so that I shall



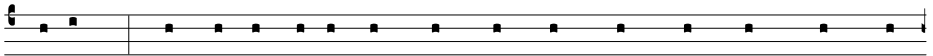
not greatly fall. 3. How long will ye imagine mischief against eve-ry man: ye



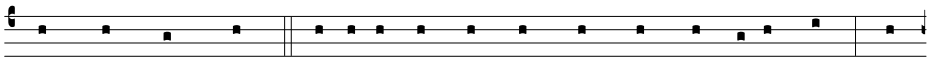
shall be slain all the sort of you; \*yea, as a tottering wall shall ye be, and like



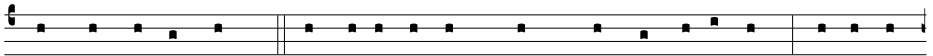
a broken hedge. 4. Their device is only how to put him out whom God will



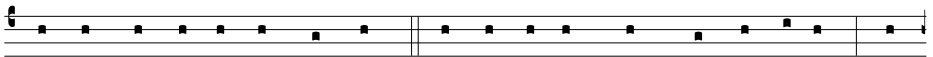
exalt: their delight is in lies; \*they give good words with their mouth, but



curse with their heart. 5. Nevertheless, my soul, wait thou still upon God: for



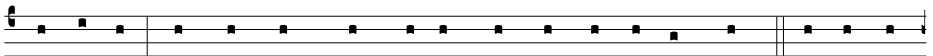
my hope is in him. 6. He truly is my strength and my salvation: he is my



defence, so that I shall not fall. 7. In God is my health, and my glory: the



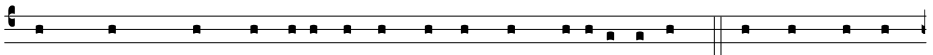
rock of my might, and in God is my trust. 8. O put your trust in him always,




ye people: pour out your hearts before him, for God is our hope. 9. As for the
